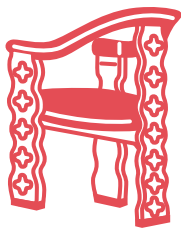


Museum bingo

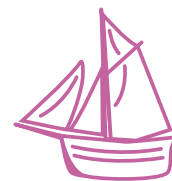

SCENIC VIEW?



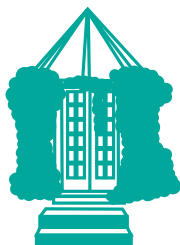

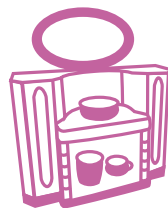
FIND SOMETHING GREEN IN
